ORDER

This cause is before the court on the report and recommendation of Magistrate Judge Linda R. Anderson entered on February 21, 2020, recommending that defendant's motion for summary judgment be granted, plaintiff's complaint be dismissed and his motion for a temporary restraining order be denied. Plaintiff has filed objections.
