## **ORDER**

That failure to advise this Court of a change of address or failure to timely comply with any order of this Court will be deemed as a purposeful delay and contumacious act by the plaintiff and will result in this cause being dismissed without prejudice and without further notice to the plaintiff.

3. That the Clerk of Court is directed to mail a copy of this order to the plaintiff at his last known address.
