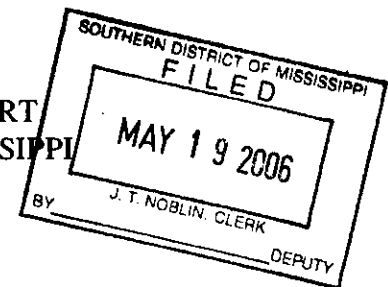

**JUDGMENT OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE**


