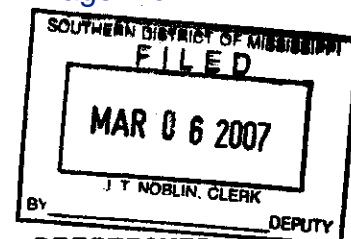

ORDER

This cause comes before this court on petitioner's "complaint/motion to resubmit" [15] filed February 22, 2007.
