

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the court on a Motion to Dismiss Defendant Rachael Fieber [49] filed by Plaintiff. As Defendant Fieber has neither “serve[d]...an answer or a motion for summary judgment,”¹ the court finds that Plaintiff may dismiss this action against Defendant Fieber without prejudice voluntarily, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff’s Motion to Dismiss Defendant Rachael Fieber [49] is GRANTED and Plaintiff’s claims against Defendant Feiber are hereby dismissed without prejudice.
