MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Currently before the Court is the Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge David Noce, to whom this matter was referred for recommended disposition pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b). On June 10, 2013, Magistrate Judge Noce filed his Report and Recommendation, recommending that the Court uphold the decision of the Administrative Law Judge to deny Plaintiff disability insurance benefits under Title II and for supplemental security income under Title XVI of the Social Security Act. Neither party has filed objections to the Report and Recommendation.


