While the undersigned is sympathetic to Plaintiff's predicament, his pro se status does not permit him to disregard the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure or this Court's Local Rules.

Plaintiff is obligated to file a brief in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 56 and E.D. Mo. L.R. 9.02, which rules include time limitations. Although Plaintiff has failed to comply with those time limitations, the Court will grant him additional time to file his brief. Failure to file the brief by the deadline set forth by the Court, however, will result in dismissal of Plaintiff's Complaint.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file his Brief in Support of the Complaint no later than August 29, 2014. Failure to comply with this Order will result in dismissal of Plaintiff's Complaint for Judicial Review of Decision of the Commissioner of Social Security.
