MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's motion for attorney's fees in the amount of \$4,368.75, pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d). Plaintiff is the prevailing party in his action challenging the Commissioner of Social Security's denial of his application for disability insurance benefits. Plaintiff seeks \$4,368.75 in fees, to be paid to Plaintiff's counsel pursuant to an assignment of fees to counsel, executed by Plaintiff. Plaintiff has submitted documentation supporting the requested amount of fees. The Commissioner responds that it does not object to the award of fees in the amount sought, but notes that *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 560 U.S. 586 (2010), mandates that the fees are to be paid directly to Plaintiff.

The Court's review of the record indicates that the amount of fees sought is reasonable and properly supported. As the Commissioner asserts, however, *Astrue v. Ratliff* requires that the fees be paid directly to Plaintiff, even in light of the assignment signed by Plaintiff.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's application for attorney's fees is

GRANTED in the amount of \$4,368.75, payable directly to Plaintiff. (Doc. No. 22.)
