## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Plaintiffs' move to file a second amended complaint,<sup>1</sup> in order to add a number of new plaintiffs. The amended complaint does not otherwise alter any of the plaintiffs' existing claims or allegations. Defendants object by referencing their arguments in previous motions. Because I find that defendants have not demonstrated that this amendment will cause them any undue prejudice and for the reasons stated in my Order of September 2, 2010 [#3332], I will grant plaintiffs' motion.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion for leave to file a

supplemental second amended complaint [#4030] is GRANTED. Plaintiffs' amended complaint is deemed filed as of this day.
