ORDER

This matter is before the Court pursuant to the Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Thomas C. Mummert, III, filed December 15, 2010. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b). The Magistrate Judge recommended that the Court grant plaintiff’s request to reverse the decision of the Commissioner and remand the case for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). Neither party has filed an objection to the recommendation.

After careful review of the matter, the Court concurs with the recommendation of the Magistrate Judge that the Commissioner’s decision in this matter should be reversed and this case remanded for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), specifically for an explanation of the Administrative Law Judge’s adverse credibility determination.

Accordingly,


