and _____, May ____, 2011, inclusively, at such date, time, and location upon which the parties might agree.

4. Nothing in this Order prejudices Defendant's rights to seek discovery from Plaintiffs on an expedited basis, subject to the Parties' agreement upon an appropriate amount of time for Plaintiffs to respond to Defendants' requests.

This schedule may be modified by Court Order, only upon written motion. Failure to comply with any part of this Order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
