MEMORANDUM AND ORDER


This matter is before the Court on plaintiff’s notice of appeal [Doc. #120]. Plaintiff, a prisoner, has not paid the appellate filing fee nor has he submitted a motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal as required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). As a result, the Court will order plaintiff to submit either the full filing fee or a motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal along with a certified copy of his prisoner account statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of the notice of appeal.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff shall either pay the \$505 appellate filing fee or submit a motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal along with a certified copy of his prisoner account statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of the notice of appeal within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall mail to plaintiff a copy of the Court's form "Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis - Prisoner Cases."
