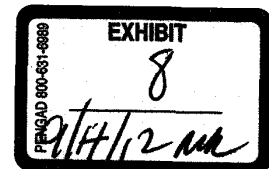

It appears you have the old standard of categories selected which is about double what our current default filtering is normally set to for a library. Do you want me to change this as well?

Here is what you need to do to add an allow/deny site individually.

Log into the server <http://tigers.more.net>

Got to Policy Management->Group Manager
 Click the 3206_SalemPublicLibrary Group
 Click "default" under the Policy heading
 Towards the bottom you should see a toggle for "local allow/deny URL list"

Choose allow and then type the site you wanted added in the field next to Add.
Click Add and then click Apply settings in the upper righthand corner of the screen. Then Click the Apply button once again to confirm.

You should be all set! Let me know if you need assistance or want me to change the default.
