

The November 8, 2010 meeting of the Salem Public Library Board was called to order by President Ruth Ann Parker with Librarian Glenda Wofford, Liz Condray, Joe Brand, Roseann Bray, Wayne Bertz, Loretta McClure, Rhonda McConnell and patron, Ana Ka Hunter in attendance.

The meeting began with patron, Ana Ka Hunter addressing the library board and sharing her concerns about the Salem Public Library regarding fines, computer usage and county membership fees. Joe Brand addressed Ms. Hunter's concerns, stating that our library strives to treat everyone fairly and he assured Ms. Hunter that the library board would look closely at her concerns and make any changes deemed necessary.

The October minutes were approved as read with a motion by Joe Brand and a second by Liz Condray.

Glenda Wofford gave the Librarian/Treasurer's Report. She noted that the first and second quarter state aid was received, as well as \$530.00 in county memberships and \$232.00 in property taxes. Money was received from the insurance company for recent water damages at the library. A motion to approve the report was made by Joe Brand and seconded by Wayne Bertz.

There were no Book Reviews.

Under correspondence, Glenda received an e-mail that a filtering upgrade will be done on November 15, 2010. A Geneology chart on the Billy Wade (Wait) Watson family was donated by Dennis Hayman.

Under Old Business, Glenda hasn't heard anything from Paul Frisbee with Anderson & Associates.

Under New Business, The Library Corporation is updating our web page to 5.1 at no charge. The mission statement will be added to the web page and fines will be explained in more detail. Kate McBride is willing to do the Library Preschool Program if she can change the day from Monday. There is a patron willing to sponsor a monthly event for children at the library, similar to the Fancy Nancy Tea Party. "Help" by Kathryn Stockett will be discussed at the November Book Talk. "Who's Who?" a program for older adults will be held on November 16, in the library meeting room.
