I find that Flores has provided notice to the Bank of America of this proceeding. Flores has appeared before me in Court and presented her request for a temporary restraining order.

I find, as I stated on the record at today’s proceeding, that the Dataphase factors weigh in favor of entering a temporary restraining order in this matter. See Dataphase Systems., Inc. v. C L Systems, Inc., 640 F.2d 109, 113 (8th Cir. 1981)


Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a temporary restraining order is entered in this matter. Defendant Bank of America is **prohibited from proceeding with any foreclosure action** ^{absent further order of this Court} on Plaintiff Dorothy Flores’ real property located at 209 St. Charles Street, Wentzville, Missouri, 63385.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall post a bond of **\$100.00** to effect this

temporary restraining order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a preliminary injunction hearing is set in this matter on **November 30, 2012 at 12:00 p.m.** in Courtroom 16 South.
