OPINION, MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter is before the Court on review of the file. On February 10, 2022, mail that this Court sent to self-represented plaintiff Klayton Brock was returned without a forwarding address, and plaintiff has not notified the Court of any change in his address. According to the Local Rules of this Court, every self-represented party is required to promptly notify the Clerk of any change in his address or telephone number. E.D.Mo. L.R. 2.06(B). "If any mail to a self-represented plaintiff or petitioner is returned to the Court without a forwarding address and the self-represented plaintiff or petitioner does not notify the Court of the change of address within thirty (30) days, the Court may, without further notice, dismiss the action without prejudice." *Id.*

In this case, more than thirty days have passed since the mail was returned, and plaintiff has not notified the Court of a change of address. The Court will therefore dismiss this action, without prejudice, pursuant to Local Rule 2.06(B).

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. A separate order of dismissal will be entered herewith.
