ORDER

On June 4, 2009, United States Magistrate Judge William A. Knox recommended dismissing plaintiff's claims against defendants George Lombardi, Dave Dormire, and Bill Galloway, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, for failure to state a claim for which relief can be granted.
