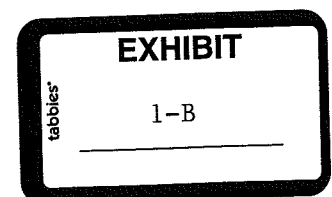

A proposed settlement (the "Settlement") has been reached in a class action lawsuit, *Janson v. LegalZoom.com, Inc.*, Case No. 2:10-cv-04018-NKL (the "lawsuit"), pending in the United States District Court for the Western District of Missouri, Central Division (the "Court"). The lawsuit claims that LegalZoom.com, Inc. ("LegalZoom") has engaged in the unauthorized practice of law in Missouri. The lawsuit also claims that LegalZoom violated the Missouri Merchandising Practices Act. LegalZoom has denied and continues to deny that it did anything wrong.

This case does not involve whether the documents you purchased through LegalZoom are valid or invalid.

Am I a Class Member? You received this notice because LegalZoom's records show you are a class member. You are a Class Member if you were resident in Missouri, purchased any of the following legal documents from LegalZoom from December 18, 2004, to May 20, 2011, and did not receive a full refund from LegalZoom:

What Does the Settlement Provide? If the Court approves the Settlement, you may be eligible to receive at least 163.2% of the amount you paid for document(s) purchased between December 18, 2007 and May 20, 2011 less any refunds you received and any shipping, filing, or additional fees you paid. If you purchased a legal document(s) between December 18, 2004 and December 17, 2007, you may be eligible to receive at least 54.4% of the price you paid for the document less any refunds you received and shipping, filing, or additional fees you paid. These payments are described in detail in the full Settlement Notice. This is only a brief summary of the benefits. You must submit a valid claim to receive any benefits. If you do not submit a claim form, you will not receive any settlement benefits. What are my rights and options in the Settlement?

Stay in and submit a claim. In order to receive a payment, you must stay in the Class in the lawsuit and submit a valid claim form online at www.jansonxxxxxxx.com by _____, 2011 or by mail to _____, received no later than _____, 2011. If you stay in the Class, you will not be able to sue or be part of any other lawsuit against LegalZoom about the legal issues in this case. You will be bound by the Court's decisions.

Exclude Yourself. If you send a written request for exclusion to the Settlement Administrator at the address below so that it is received by _____, 2011, you will keep your right to sue LegalZoom on your own. **If you do not exclude yourself**, you will be bound by the terms of the Settlement and give up your right to sue about the issues in this case.

Comment. You may comment on the Settlement if you wish. Write to the Court about the Settlement so that your comments are received by _____, 2011. You must remain in the Class to comment in support of or in opposition to the Settlement. If you do not exclude yourself, you or your lawyer have the right to appear before the Court and comment on the proposed Settlement. Do Nothing. You will receive no economic benefits and give up rights to sue.
