

16 Q. The Articles of Incorporation, if we look at the second page of Exhibit 90 -- and those are the 17 Articles of Incorporation, are they not? 18

19 A. Yes, this is -- looks like page 1 of the 20 Articles of Incorporation.

Q Are these Articles of Incorporation a document that would be generated by LegalZoom and sent to the Missouri Secretary of State if the customer so elects?

A. Could you repeat that, please.

THE WITNESS: The template for the Articles of Incorporation was developed, I believe, by the Missouri Secretary of State so a customer that selects and would like to file a nonprofit corporation would have their answers from the questionnaire populated onto this document, onto the form that was provided by the Secretary of State, and then this form would be sent to 14 the Secretary of State

BY MR BUTSCH: 15

O So LegalZoom has the form for Articles of 16 17 Incorporation that it obtained from the Missouri Secretary of State and it stores that form electronically? The customer provides information and 19 does not fill in this form directly, but answers a 20

series of questions, and based on those answers that are 21 provided, those answers are imported into the form that

is provided by the Missouri Secretary of State. And 23 this occurs through the operation of LegalZoom's 24

25 website; is that correct? liability company, is that something that can be created

through the use of LegalZoom's website for its Missouri

3 customers, do you know?

A. I do not know for sure, but as I said, I do know that in some states and for certain entities we do offer a service for dissolution of limited liability companies

Q. You're not sure if that applies to Missouri or 8 not; is that what your testimony is --9

A. That's correct.

Q -- today?

We've talked about this process by which a customer seeking to obtain a particular document, let's 13 say a power of attorney, a will, a trust, a lease, a pet protection agreement, the formation of a limited liability company, that they obtain access to the LegalZoom website and they proceed to answer particular questions. The answers to those questions are used in the creation of the final legal documents that would be used by that particular customer, correct?

A. That appears to be a correct characterization.

Q. Has that method, that methodology that I'm talking about where a series of questions are posed to a customer and then the answers to those questions are transported, imported into what ultimately become the

final legal documents that are delivered by LegalZoom to the customer, that methodology, has that been the same 3 since the founding of LegalZoom to the present date? 4 The methodology that we're just talking about. 5

A For the documents that utilize the questionnaire and the branching technology, and for the products and services where people can choose to create their own legal documents that use that technology, the answer is "yes," because as I've talked about before, there are other services that LegalZoom offers such as 10 11 downloadable forms, and in the past there have been 12 other services that you can obtain through the LegalZoom website that did not always go through that same 14 process.

15 Q But that process with respect to those 16 documents that we have talked about and that I just mentioned where we used that branching technology and 17 the information is taken from the answers given and 18 imported or transported to those documents that 19 ultimately become the final legal documents that 20 customers receive, that basic operation or premise has 22 always been utilized by LegalZoom?

23 A If you're referring to those documents that we have been talking about today such as the last wills or 24 the pet protection agreement or the LLC documents, then

general process of coming through the website and 2 answering the questionnaire and then proceeding with a payment and then having the document delivered by mail, that general process would be the same.

Q. With regard to Chad Ferrell and Gerald Ardrey, two gentlemen who formed an LLC through LegalZoom in January of 2008, would their experience in the formation of a limited liability company through the use of LegalZoom's website, would their experience be any different today in February of 2011 than it was in January of 2008?

12 A. I think my -- I think that the general process of how they would go through the questionnaire and then 13 proceed to payment and then obtain the Articles of 14 15 Organization that were filed would be the same, but I believe that there would be some differences in terms of the questions that were asked, the features and what you 17 18 obtain for the price that you pay in the packages, so it 19 would be a different package of what you purchase, but 20 the general interaction would be similar.

21 O Are you aware sitting here today of any differences in the package that Mr. Ferrell and 22 Mr. Ardrey would have received in January of 2008 than a 23 customer who would seek to form a limited liability company today in February of 2011 utilizing the 25

Q Can you explain that for me.

4 A. One of the differences now is that some of our packages come with accounting software that's valued at \$99. Some of our packages include a press release through PRWeb that has - I'm not sure what the value of it, but there's a monetary value of that as well.

9 Those are just two things that come to mind, but there are other differences in the composition of 10 the packages so that a customer who places an order 11 today may not have placed an order two years ago because we didn't have some of those additional products and 13 features that were bundled into our packages 14

O. So it sounds like today as opposed to two or three years ago there may be additional features beyond what someone -- beyond what may have been available in the past, right?

A. That is correct, and there may be something else, and I don't know if it's offered in Missouri, but there are other features and plans that are available. 21 I know Missouri has another plan which is a subscription 22 plan for downloadable forms and documents so that a customer who purchases an LLC can subscribe to our -what we call a business advantage plan that provides
