1 As explained in the Suggestions in Support of Plaintiffs' Fee Motion ("Suggestions"), the lodestar hours for each biller (Column C herein) equals the number of hours he or she expended on the case less the number of expended hours the biller deemed arguably excessive, redundant or otherwise unnecessary ("excessive hours"). The Suggestions specify, for each biller individually, the percentage reductions for excessive hours. The percentage reductions for excessive hours for all billers collectively is 15.1% (=Column D total herein/Column C total herein). Each biller's fee claim (Column G herein) is the product of his or her countable fee claim hours (Column E herein=lodestar hours minus 10%) and the biller's requested hourly rate (Column F herein).
