question in this action. The Court also lacks divers	sity jurisdi	iction over this action as Plaintiff and
all Defendants are citizens of Missouri.		
Accordingly, because the Court lacks subject matter jurisdiction over this matter, this		
cause of action is hereby DISMISSED. The Clerk of the Court is directed to terminate all		
pending motions and mark this action as closed.
