On February 20, 2018, the Court issued an Order setting a preliminary pretrial conference for March 28, 2018.<sup>1</sup>

In its February 20, 2018, Order, the Court required that “[e]ach party shall file a preliminary pretrial statement, which shall identify each individual and include each matter listed in Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(1)(A)(i)-(iii) and in L.R. 16.2(b)(1).”<sup>2</sup> The preliminary pretrial statements filed on March 19, 2018,<sup>3</sup> fail to

comply with the Court's February 20, 2018, Order.

Deficiencies in the March 19, 2018, statements include:


1. Plaintiff's Preliminary Pretrial Statement<sup>4</sup> does not include the matter listed in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(1)(A)(ii), as required by the Court's February 20, 2018, Order.

2. Defendants' Preliminary Pretrial Statement<sup>5</sup> does not include the matter listed in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(1)(A)(ii), as required by the Court's February 20, 2018, Order.

ORDERED:

Necessary and appropriate revisions to the preliminary pretrial statements to address the deficiencies outlined in paragraph numbers 1 and 2 above shall be filed and served on or before March 23, 2018.
