ORDER

Defendant Allied Professionals Insurance Company has moved for admission of Michael B. ORDERED:

He must do his own writing, sign his own pleadings, motions, briefs and other documents served or filed by him, and, if designated co-lead counsel, must appear and participate personally in all proceedings before the Court. Local counsel shall also sign all such pleadings, motions and briefs and other documents served or filed.

Admission is personal to Kadish; it is not an admission of The Kadish Law Group.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

This Order will be withdrawn unless Kadish, within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order, files an acknowledgment and acceptance of his admission under the terms set forth above.
