deficient in at least the following particulars:

- 1. Plaintiff's Pretrial Statement<sup>2</sup> fails to comply with the disclosure requirements of L.R. 16.2(b)(1)(E) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(1)(A)(ii)-(iii).
- 2. Defendant Equifax Inc.'s Preliminary Pretrial Statement<sup>3</sup> fails to comply with the disclosure requirements of L.R. 16.2(b)(1)(J) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(1)(A)(i)-(ii).

#### ORDERED:

Each party shall file an amended preliminary pretrial statement, addressing with strict compliance each matter listed in Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(1)(A)(i)-(iii) and L.R. 16.2(b)(1) on or before March 16, 2018. Failure to file an amended preliminary pretrial statement in full compliance with the terms of this Order could result, without motion, in the imposition of sanctions.
