1. Plaintiff's Preliminary Pretrial Statement<sup>4</sup> does not address the matters listed in Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(1)(A)(iii) and L.R. 16.2(b)(1)(E) and required by the Court's May 29, 2018, Order.

2. Defendant's Rule 26(a)(1) Initial Disclosure<sup>5</sup> does not address the matters listed in L.R. 16.2(b)(1) and required by the Court's May 29, 2018, Order.

ORDERED:

Necessary and appropriate revisions to the preliminary pretrial statements to address the deficiencies outlined in paragraphs 1 and 2 above shall be filed and served on or before July 6, 2018.
