Montana as Defense allege. Montana ranks last for justice, corruption, bias in local, county, state and federal courts in Montana. Defense counsel for Defendant City wish court to believe alleged criminal behavior without probable cause, unsigned police reports, police reports without probable cause are useful to the Defense. Spreadbury was charged with trespass on public property as one count to 13 visits by Defendant City Police Department, protected in 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment US Constitution, denied by US Judge Malloy.

Defendant Chief Oster was videotaped in Plaintiff home as unauthorized entry October 4, 2011 as defined as Montana Code Ann. MCA§ 45-6-201 which brings charges of trespass on public property MCA§ 45-6-203(a) and Official Misconduct MCA§ 45-7-401(b)(c). Plaintiff remitted 32 sec video of Defendant Chief Oster, Defendant Detective Murphy for evidence of continuous civil right violation for liberty, equal protection Exhibit B ignored by the Honorable Court.

Defense request for sealed police reports will bring more liability to Defense, more deprivation of Plaintiff rights not upheld in this Honorable court. Issuance letter of security clearance is attached as Exhibit A to this pleading.

Spreadbury has no control over Montana Supreme court allowing crime in courtroom in Montana on two occasions, upholding crime without probable cause on November 4, 2009 speaking to Defendant Roddy without threat. Exhibit B

attached to this pleading is an online report entitled "Find my Threat", the non-probable cause felony irrelevant to case, yet allowed by this Honorable biased court. Order of protection for Defendant Roddy admittedly without finding of fact, conclusion of law by Defendant CityJudge Michael J. Reardon in violation of Montana Rules of Civ. Procedure 52(a); this biased court upholds.

Spreadbury is not entitled to constitutional rights by order of Judge Malloy in paid conflict to this matter (see 3<sup>rd</sup> request for recusal of this date) 28 USC§ 455 et. seq.
