
Pending is Plaintiff Michael E. Spreadbury's renewed motion seeking to disqualify me under 28 U.S.C. § 455. (Dkt # 129.) This renewed motion regurgitates the arguments addressed in the Order dated August 29, 2011 (dkt # 101).

The ruling on this issue is binding on all parties. While Spreadbury is unhappy and is disposed to truculent exaggeration, any further motions seeking my disqualification will be stricken. Under Local Rule 7.3, "no party may file a
