As I had never seen him I had staff who has had confrontations with him positively identify him. I then called the City of Hamilton Police Department to report Spreadbury's presence on library property. A few minutes later Officer Snavelly spoke with Spreadbury at the gazebo. After several minutes in conversation with Officer Snavelly, I observed Spreadbury leaving the library premises.

Officer Snavelly then spoke with me about Spreadbury leaving the premises saying he will bring documents to Snavelly concerning his banning from the library and his earlier letter to me reinstating library privileges for him. Officer Snavelly said he will write up a report. He did not cite Spreadbury this time, but he advised me that if Spreadbury comes onto library property again, call the police.
