I was walking out of the library, down the stairs and stepping off the curve to an open parking space to get to my car across the street at 11:55. Michael Spreadbury pulled into the space I was occupying. I stepped to the side and kept walking once I recognized him. He got out of his truck, acting agitated. He directed his agitation at me and told me that it was up to me to get the charges dropped in an upcoming trial between the library and himself. He instructed me to go to Ken Bell's office and cancel the trial. He became more and more agitated and became intimidating when I informed him that I wasn't in a position to respond to his request. He talked about a variety of issues during this brief encounter as I nudged my way out of the space I was in to escape him when he raised his fists at me more than several times.

Some of the issues he brought up:

Only I have the ability to cancel the trial.

He has always been nice to me, hadn't he?

The system has broken him (started to cry)

Some of my responses were:



I am not in a position to get involved.

Yes, you are a nice man.

I am sorry you are unhappy.

When Michael raised his fists at me, I ran to my car for protection as I had my keys out and thought in advance I could lock myself in. In the mean time, a truck stopped for me as I ran across the street. Michael left immediately and I ran over to the truck driver to inquire if he would be a witness to the scene. He informed he didn't see anything. As I went to my car, Gavin was standing by the curb. He had witnessed the incident and came out because he was concerned for my safety. He observed the entire scene from the window of his office.

I informed Gloria, filed a restraining order against Michael Spreadbury at the City of Hamilton Police Department. Spreadbury turned himself in 3 days later after numerous attempts by the Sheriff's office to serve him. The case has been referred to the Attorney General's Office in Helena due to a variety of issues I am not privy to. Michael has two charges in his criminal history of abuse against women.
