Hamilton Library to Open Pedophilia Room with Public Funds

Hamilton, MT- The Bitterroot Public Library, a member library of the Montana State Library System is announcing the opening of a pedophilia room in the basement of the state sponsored library. After story time, parents are invited to allow their children into the Michael Jackson inspired room, which the staff refer to as "Neverland". It is equipped with mood lighting, and a 1950's soda fountain, to help the "...Children feel more comfortable" says assistant Director Nansu Roddy who explained that the children are encouraged to have "...a coke and a smile."

All of the improvements were approved by Dr. Robert Brophy, library Chairman whose statutory task is to perform all essential duties in accordance with the law in the State of Montana. Brophy explained that he is assured that the MMIA insurance offered to counter any community complaints is more than adequate to cover any "mishaps".

Montana State Librarian, Darlene Staffeldt commented "The State Library Commission and the State Library have no authority to dictate how or from what source a public library or library district obtains its insurance coverage". Unfortunate for Brophy, Staffeldt and the Montana State Library, The Montana Municipal Interlocal Authority (MMIA) can only insure municipalities in the State of Montana. By obtaining insurance coverage as an unauthorized entity, the Bitterroot Public Library would be committing the white collar crime of public fraud. By using the unauthorized insurance, it is the improper and unlawful use of public funds, to which the State librarian has obviously condoned.

Abuse of Public funds is not anything new for the Bitterroot Public Library. The fiscal budget for 2009-2010 used 63% or \$284,000 for Administrative costs such as staff pay, pension, and benefits. Purchases for books and other materials only amounted to 1 in every 9 dollars of the publically funded budget. With nearly \$500,000 in the bank, it is wondered why an independent library district would defraud the public by accepting litigation representation from MMIA. Our guess is that fraud and crime is so predominate within the State of Montana, even the State Librarian looks the other way. The Bitterroot Public Library is staffed mostly by volunteers in Hamilton, Montana.
