**CHARGE 1-**

On or about November 4, 2009, the Defendant, with the purpose to cause Nancy Reddy to perform or to omit the performance of her acts as a witness to a prior criminal offense committed by the Defendant, communicated to Reddy a threat of physical harm to Reddy. The threat was communicated under circumstances that reasonably tended to produce a fear that the threat would be carried out.
