On May 31, 2012, United States Magistrate Judge Jeremiah C. Lynch entered an order granting Plaintiff Michael E. Spreadbury's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismissing all claims with prejudice. He instructed Spreadbury that the Court would reconsider the Order if Spreadbury either withdrew his motion to dismiss or filed a notice requesting an opportunity to be heard as to why the dismissal should not be with prejudice. Spreadbury did neither. Pursuant to


Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b)(1), Judge Lynch now recommends that his May 31, 2012 Order be affirmed and judgment entered accordingly.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Judge Lynch's recommendation (doc. 309) is adopted in full.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all of Spreadbury's remaining claims are **DISMISSED** with prejudice under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2).
