INITIAL WRITTEN BY 037REICHE ON 06/16/2009

ON JUNE 16, 2009 AT APPROXIMATELY 1045 HOURS GLORIA LANGSTAFF FROM THE BITTERROOT PUBLIC LIBRARY WALKED INTO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND WANTED TO MAKE A COMPLAINT. LANGSTAFF SAID THAT SHE AND THE LIBRARY STAFF WERE BEING HARASSED BY MICHAEL SPREADBURY.

LANGSTAFF TOLD ME THAT SHE HAD MICHAEL SPREADBURY TRESPASSED FROM THE LIBRARY BECAUSE HE WAS BEING DISRUPTIVE AND THE LIBRARY STAFF FELT THREATENED.

LANGSTAFF ADVISED ME THAT PRIOR TO SPREADBURY BEING TRESPASSED FROM THE LIBRARY, SHE HAD ARRANGED TO HAVE A MEETING WITH HIM REGARDING HIS LITERATURE THAT HE WANTED ON DISPLAY AT THE LIBRARY.

LANGSTAFF SAID THAT HER MEETING WITH SPREADBURY WAS SET FOR 1030 HOURS ON JUNE 16, 2009 AT THE LIBRARY. LANGSTAFF STATED THAT AT APPROXIMATELY 1000 HOURS TODAY, SPREADBURY CALLED HER AND ASKED IF THEY WERE STILL HAVING A MEETING. LANGSTAFF TOLD ME THAT SHE ADVISED SPREADBURY THAT SHE WAS CANCELLING THE MEETING. LANGSTAFF SAID THAT SPREADBURY ASKED IF SHE WOULD MEET HIM AT ANOTHER LOCATION INSTEAD OF THE LIBRARY SINCE HE IS TRESPASSED FROM THERE, AND SHE TOLD HIM NO.

LANGSTAFF SAID THAT SPREADBURY CALLED BACK A FEW MINUTES LATER, BUT HE SPOKE WITH A STAFF MEMBER AT THE REFERENCE DESK. LANGSTAFF SAID THAT SPREADBURY ASKED FOR HIS PERSONAL BELONGINGS BACK. LANGSTAFF GAVE ME A BINDER THAT HAD SPREADBURY'S WRITINGS IN IT AND TOLD ME THAT THE BINDER IS WHAT SPREADBURY WANTED.

I TOLD LANGSTAFF THAT SPREADBURY'S ACTIONS WERE NOT HARASSMENT AND THAT HE HAD A RIGHT TO ASK FOR HIS PERSONAL PROPERTY BACK. I TOLD LANGSTAFF THAT I WOULD TAKE THE BINDER AND HAVE SPREADBURY COME TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PICK IT UP SO THAT SHE AND SPREADBURY DON'T HAVE TO HAVE CONTINUED CONTACT.

LANGSTAFF STATED THAT SHE UNDERSTOOD.

I THEN CALLED SPREADBURY AND LEFT HIM A MESSAGE THAT HIS PERSONAL PROPERTY WAS AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND HE COULD COME PICK IT UP DURING BUSINESS HOURS.
