Before the Court is CARD's motion for the admission of attorney John Day of the John Day Law Office, *pro hac vice*, in the above-captioned matter. (Doc. 152.) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is subject to withdrawal unless Mr. Day files a separate pleading acknowledging his admission under the terms set forth above within fifteen (15) days of this Order.
