IT IS ORDERED:

- 1) Defendant's motions to continue trial, (filing nos. <u>61</u> and <u>63</u>), are granted, and
 - a. A jury trial is set to commence on December 7, 2009. No more than five days are allocated to the trial of this case and counsel shall plan accordingly. This case is set as the first civil case, but is subject to the prior trial of any criminal cases scheduled to commence that week.

Counsel shall provide Judge Kopf with a draft pretrial conference order at this pretrial conference and the draft order shall conform to the requirements of the local rules.

The plaintiff's objections to the defendant's notices to serve Rule 45 records subpoenas, (filing no. <u>62</u>), are denied without prejudice to refiling should the parties be unable to resolve this dispute without court intervention.
