Petitioner has filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus under <u>28 U.S.C.</u> § <u>2254</u> (Filing No. <u>1</u>), a Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis (Filing No. <u>2</u>), and a copy of his institutional trust account statement (Filing No. 3).

Habeas corpus cases attacking the legality of a person's confinement require the payment of a \$5.00 fee. <u>28 U.S.C.</u> § <u>1914(a)</u>. The Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis (Filing No. $\underline{2}$) is provisionally granted and Petitioner will not be required to pay the \$5.00 fee at this time.
