This matter is before the court upon Plaintiff's application for attorney fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412. (Filing <u>32</u>.) Plaintiff requests fees in the total amount of \$3,924.38, which represents 22.75 hours of work by her attorneys at an average hourly rate of \$172.50.¹ It is requested that payment be made directly to Plaintiff's counsel. Defendant does not oppose Plaintiff's application. *See* filing <u>34</u>.

The court has determined that Plaintiff was indeed the prevailing party in this action, as the Commissioner's decision was reversed and matter remanded for further proceedings; that the position of the Commissioner was not substantially justified; that the application for fees was filed in a timely fashion; and that Plaintiff's net worth did not exceed \$2 million when the action was filed. Plaintiff therefore is entitled to an award of reasonable attorney fees.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Plaintiff's application for attorneys fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act (filing $\underline{32}$) is granted.

2. By separate document, the court shall enter judgment for Plaintiff and against Defendant, providing that Plaintiff is awarded attorney fees of \$3,924.38, to be paid directly to Plaintiff's counsel.
