An email will be sent to counsel of record with the instructions and codes for participating in the pretrial conference by WebEx.
- A telephonic conference with the undersigned magistrate judge will be held on **November 5, 2013** at **11:00 a.m.** to discuss the status of case progression and potential settlement. Counsel for plaintiff shall place the call.
- 4) The deadline for completing written discovery under Rules 33 through 36 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure is November 15, 2013. Motions to compel Rule 33 through 36 discovery must be filed by November 1, 2013.

5) The deadlines for identifying expert witnesses expected to testify at the trial are:

For the plaintiff(s): October 4, 2013. For the defendant(s): November 4, 2013.

The deadlines for complete expert disclosures, (both retained experts, (<u>Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(2)(B)</u>), and non-retained experts, (<u>Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(2)(C)</u>), are:

For the plaintiff(s): October 4, 2013
For the defendant(s): November 4, 2013

- 8) The deadline for filing motions to dismiss and motions for summary judgment is November 15, 2013.
- 9) The deadline for filing motions to exclude testimony on Daubert and related grounds is November 15, 2013.
- 10) No additional extensions will be granted absent a substantial showing of good cause.
