In a memorandum and order entered on October 14, 2015 (Filing No. [26](#)), Magistrate Judge Cheryl R. Zwart denied Plaintiff's motion to disqualify all attorneys employed by the City of Lincoln Attorney's Office from representing any Defendant in this action (Filing No. [16](#)). On October 26, 2015, Plaintiff filed a statement of objections to the order (Filing No. [31](#)).
