This court previously denied Plaintiff leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis because Plaintiff signed neither his Notice of Appeal (Filing No. [7](#)), nor his Motion for Leave to Appeal in Forma Pauperis (Filing No. [8](#)). That rule requires all pro se parties to personally sign every pleading, written motion, and other paper they submit to the court. (Filing No. [9](#).)

Plaintiff has filed an Objection (Filing No. [11](#)) to this order. For the same reasons discussed in this court’s prior order (Filing No. [9](#)), Plaintiff’s Objection shall be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff’s Objection (Filing No. [11](#)) to this court’s prior order (Filing No. [9](#)) is denied.
