- 1. The plaintiff's claims against Does 1 through 25 are dismissed pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m).
- 2. Does 1 through 25 are terminated as parties.
- 3. This case is dismissed.

4. A separate judgment will be entered.
