This matter is before the court upon Plaintiff's application for attorney fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412 (<u>filing 30</u>). Plaintiff requests fees in the total amount of \$2,283.75, which represents 13.05 hours of work by his attorney, at an average hourly rate of \$175.00. Defendant does not oppose Plaintiff's application. *See* filing 32.

The court has determined that Plaintiff was indeed the prevailing party in this action, as the Commissioner's decision was reversed and matter remanded for further proceedings; that the application for fees was filed in a timely fashion; and that the position of the Commissioner was not substantially justified. Plaintiff therefore is entitled to an award of reasonable attorney fees.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff's application for attorneys fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act (<u>filing 30</u>) is granted; and
- 2. By separate document, the court shall enter judgment for Plaintiff and against Defendant, providing that Plaintiff is awarded attorney fees of \$2,283.75.
