Petitioner has filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus under $\underline{28 \text{ U.S.C.}}$ § $\underline{2254}$ (filing no. $\underline{1}$), an application to proceed in forma pauperis (filing no. $\underline{2}$), and a copy of his institutional trust account statement (filing no. $\underline{7}$).

The application to proceed in forma pauperis (filing no. $\underline{2}$) is provisionally granted and Petitioner will not be required to pay the \$5.00 fee at this time.
