This matter is before the court on its own motion. On August 10, 2009, the court permitted Plaintiff's claims to proceed against Defendants Lnu and Unknown Officers. (Filing No. 11.) Plaintiff had 120 days, or until December 1, 2009, to complete service of process. (1d.) It is now December 16, 2009, and Plaintiff has not returned the completed summons forms to the Clerk of the court for service on Defendants. (See Docket Sheet.)

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- Plaintiff shall have until January 5, 2010, to show cause why this case should not be dismissed. If Plaintiff does not respond, or if good cause is not shown, this action will be dismissed without prejudice and without further notice; and
- 2. The Clerk of the court is directed to set a pro se case management deadline with the following text: January 5, 2010: deadline for Plaintiff to show cause why service of process was not completed.
