This matter is before the Court on the motion of plaintiff Tyrone Patterson for reconsideration of the Court's order regarding the award of attorney's fees and costs (Filing No. 119). The Court filed a memorandum opinion and order and judgment denying plaintiff's motion on January 28, 2013, after the seven-day period for a reply under Nebraska Civil Rule 7.1(c) had run. Further review of the local rules revealed that plaintiff should have been accorded an additional three days under Rule 6.1(b). - 3) Plaintiff's motion to place Exhibit 3 (Filing No. 119-4) under seal is granted.
- 4) Plaintiff's motion to strike or seal defendant's exhibit containing the statements of the jury is denied.
