This matter is before me on the Motion to Stay Pending Exhaustion on State Remedies, filed by the petitioner, Dwight L. Tucker. (Filing No. <u>21</u>.) Tucker asks me to stay this matter so that he may exhaust his state remedies. (<u>Id</u>.) The respondents object, stating that Tucker's Petition Under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 for Writ of Habeas Corpus by a Person in State Custody is not a mixed petition containing exhausted and unexhausted claims and there are no state court remedies available for Tucker to relitigate his claims. (Filing No. <u>22</u> at CM/ECF pp. 1-2.) Tucker's motion to stay has been carefully reviewed and I conclude that there is no basis upon which to grant a stay.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Tucker's Motion to Stay Pending Exhaustion of State Remedies (filing no. <u>21</u>) is denied; and
- 2. the respondents' Objection to Stay (filing no. <u>22</u>) is sustained.
