This matter is before the Court on two motions. First, plaintiff asks (Filing No.  $\underline{30}$ ) the Court to reconsider its order (Filing No.  $\underline{27}$ ) dated January 5, 2015, dismissing her case. That motion will be denied.

Second, plaintiff seeks leave to appeal in forma pauperis (Filing No.  $\underline{34}$ ). Plaintiff has submitted the requisite information to the Court. After review of the plaintiff's documents, the Court will deny her motion to proceed in forma pauperis. The plaintiff has a job with income sufficient to pay the \$505 filing fee (Filing No.  $\underline{34}$ , at 1). The docket reflects that the plaintiff had sufficient funds to pay the \$400 filing fee in district court on October 20, 2014, and that her motion to proceed in forma pauperis was denied as moot (Filing No. <u>8</u>). IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motions (Filing No. 30 and Filing No. 34) are denied.
