This matter is before the court on its own motion. Plaintiff filed a Complaint (Filing No. [1](#)) on March 13, 2015. However, Plaintiff failed to include the \$400.00 filing and administrative fees. 2. The clerk of the court is directed to send to Plaintiff the Form AO240 (“Application to Proceed Without Prepayment of Fees and Affidavit”).

3. The clerk of the court is directed to set a pro se case management deadline in this matter with the following text: April 20, 2015: Check for MIFP or payment.
