This matter is before the Court on the Motion to Dismiss (Filing No. 11) filed by Plaintiff Woodmen of the World Life Insurance Society. Plaintiff filed an Application to Confirm Arbitration Award (Filing No. 1) on February 11, 2016. The Court will not assess costs or attorney's fees. Accordingly,

(Filing No. 11) is granted;

- 2. The Application to Confirm Arbitration Award (Filing No. 1) is dismissed without prejudice; and
- 3. The Court will not assess costs or attorney's fees.
