This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion to Substitute Expert and Continue Deadline for Disclosure of Expert Testimony (<u>Filing No. 58</u>). Defense counsel notified the Court by e-mail that the Motion is not opposed.

The Final Progression Order currently provides July 1, 2017, as the deadline for Plaintiffs to serve all opposing parties with the statement required by Fed. R. Civ.
